SPECIAL 10th ANNIVERSARY CONCERT OF THE GROUP "EMANUEL"

"SONGS FROM THE HEART"



San José de las Lajas, September 25 – Saturday, September 20, 2008, Group "Emanuel" gave a special concert marking its tenth anniversary.

At this important event, members of the group were accompanied by a youth chorus and a guest pianist. They sang twenty numbers – the most stirring and evangelistic were taken from their three CDs ("Peace I Give to You", "You Want Me to Sing to You", and "Be Still and Listen").

It should be pointed out that the selection of songs – primarily targeted at youth – evidenced a broad range of musical genres. During the performance the audience enjoyed rap, reggae ton, and also ballads, salsa, and bachata. The group regularly experiments with its musical presentations and this was evident in each of its songs.

Despite the heat, the concert was a great success and provided an opportunity for informal dialogue – almost like members of a big family -- between the members of the musical "team" and those attending. Members of the audience joined the group in singing familiar numbers such as "We Have Hope" and even tried some new songs like "Be Still and Listen".

The Lord was present all the time: The three members of Group Emanuel sang, guided by the Holy Spirit. With the Lord's help and the support of the other brothers and sisters, they overcame difficulties often encountered in concerts, putting behind them the hard work of preparation, their fatigue, failures in the sound system, etc. They truly put on an excellent performance which everyone enjoyed and appreciated.

A special and moving moment: Those attending the concert contributed to a special offering for the victims of the Hurricanes Gustav and Ike, reaffirming Philippians 2:13 "for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose". It was an act of love and good will which again made clear how appropriate and important it is to follow the example of Jesus Christ in these tumultuous times.

Group Emanuel is at an important point it its artistic life. After two years without recording a new CD, 2008 saw the members complete a successful national tour and produce their latest CD "Be Still and Listen". In addition, its 10th Anniversary concert was a marvelous musical testimony and demonstrated the group's bold stand as an instrument of God in the spreading of the Gospel. The performance also made clear that musical styles such as rap and reggae ton should in no way be causes of tension in church music. It is truly possible to praise and worship God with this style of music, as these young men do ... because they sing **Songs from the Heart**.

May the members of Group Emanuel have many more years singing to the Lord. God Bless You!

Poetry in Rap

Born in Brooklyn, New York, the youngest of seven children to Puerto Rican parents, Antonio spoke very little English until starting school at age five. By age 15. Antonio and his family moved to California where he attended Dominguez High School in Compton. Upon graduating he joined the Navy and became a world traveler by the age of 21. Recounting his numerous port visits and life experiences he began writing poetry at this time in the form of rap. In 1984, Antonio moved to Tacoma Washington where he became well known for rapping at parties and local radio stations.

In 1993 he obtained a certification from Clover Park Technical College as a Media Specialist. Since then Antonio has produced several documentaries, local television programs for TV Tacoma and KBTC as well as countless PSA's (public service announcements) and promos.

In 1997 Antonio was offered a scholarship to attended one quarter at Tacoma Community College's Bridge Program. The Bridge program is a collaboration between TCC and The Evergreen State College and where Antonio's creativity will meet a Liberal Arts education. Being exposed to more historically accurate information and studying writing styles, Antonio began writing Spoken Word pieces to interpret what he had learned. He was given full credit by his instructors as he applied extensive research, critical thinking skills, and creative self expression to the materials provided. As a result Antonio's writing evolved and his rap evolved into spoken word. He's written several powerful Spoken Word pieces. In them Antonio addresses life's struggles, Spirituality and Politics. He completed his memoirs in 2003 and graduated from The Evergreen State College Tacoma Campus with a Bachelors of Arts Degree in 2004.

Today Antonio Edwards is one of the areas most sought after Poets. He has been delivering powerful Spoken Word performances in and around Tacoma for the past five years. Venues include but not limited to: Universities, Coffee Shops, Restaurants, Public Schools, Churches, Festivals Cultural Celebrations, Funerals, Birthday Parties, Anniversaries, Bus Stops and Street Corners.

Below is one of his poems:

We represent GOD, when we walk into a room Despite of what we've done Or anything we've consumed You see, GOD is always ready to start over Always ready to re-zoom Grace and Mercy For those of us late to bloom In any and in all directions Always seeing his face when we will look at our reflection The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me And because God has anointed me I will preach good tidings to the meek He has sent me to bind up the
